



Noah's Ark Pre-school - Extended Hours.

From September 2019 Noah's Ark will be extending their hours. We will be able to provide care for up to 9 ¼ hours a day with places for a limited number of children at our Breakfast and After Pre-school clubs. For more information see below or contact the office.

Early Birds Breakfast Club will run from Tuesday to Thursday 7.45 – 8.45 am in the Orange Room. Noah's Ark will provide cereal, toast and a drink of milk or water and a space for children to play.

Night Owls Twilight Club will run from Monday to Thursday from 3.30 – 5.00 and will be in the Green room. Noah's Ark will provide a healthy snack and a drink. There will be a quiet area and access to the outside play area.

Opening Hours from September 2019:

- **Monday** 8.45 – 5.00 (no breakfast club)
- **Tuesday** 7.45 – 5.00
- **Wednesday** 7.45 – 5.00
- **Thursday** 7.45 – 5.00
- **Friday** 8.45 – 3.30 (no extended hours)

What is the cost of the extended hours? Like lunch club, the cost of additional care is £5 per club regardless of the length of the club. You will be invoiced for this at the same time as your termly fees.

Can I use my Universal FEEE (15 hours) and Extended FEEE (additional 15 hours) to pay for this extra care? Yes, provided that you have unallocated funded hours and your claim falls within the limits of the scheme(s). For further information, please contact the Noah's Ark office.

Do I need to provide food for my child? Noah's Ark will provide food for the children at both the Early Bird Breakfast club and Night Owl Twilight Clubs. We will provide healthy cereal, toast and a drink for breakfast and a light snack at tea time.

Does my child need to attend the whole session? No. You can drop off and pick up your child when convenient. However, if you have booked for the club, you will be required to pay for the full session.

At what age can my child access these additional hours? All Noah's Ark pre-school children will be eligible to access these extended hours (7.45 – 8.45am and 3.30-5pm) if required and space permitting.

How do I book a place for my child? Places are limited, like our daytime sessions we ask that you include these extended hours when you are agreeing your sessions here at Noah's Ark. Any extended sessions chosen would be for the entire term and you would be required to give a terms notice if you wished to change any agreed extended sessions
