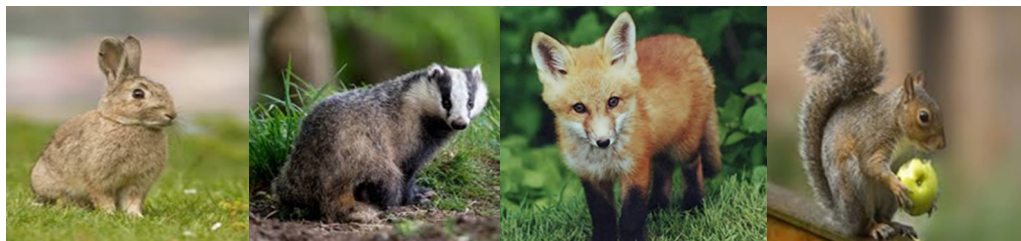

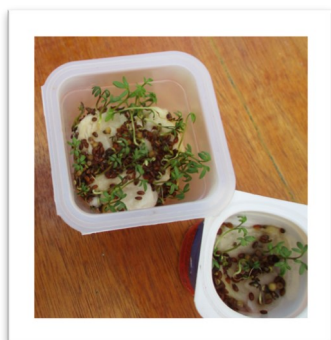

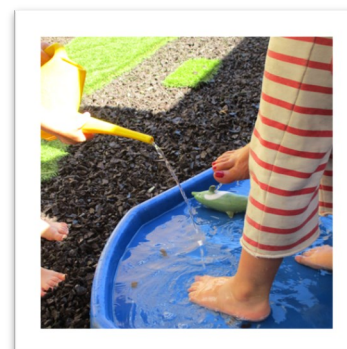
News from the Rooms
