This week we have been counting. Children have been immersed in thinking about **numbers**; counting forwards and backwards, rolling dice, clapping numbers, counting objects, estimating and ordering. We have used our number knowledge at the Woodwork table too, counting nails and screws and measuring our creations using a tape measure.



Focussing on numbers this week has helped the children to develop a positive interest in Mathematics, to look for patterns and connections and to 'have a go' without being afraid of making a mistake.
