This week we have been talking about our emotions and understanding how we can feel differently depending on what is going on. Children experience a whole range of emotions but can sometimes find it hard to express exactly what and how they are feeling. By understanding their emotions can help them regulate their feelings.

In Thinking time we talked about how our face might look if we were sad, happy, excited or cross and then had a go at drawing a picture of a face to show how this might look.

We have also been looking at letters and sounds, we made trumpets out of paper and then used them to make different sounds. We have also be creating letters from the playdough.

The children have enjoyed exploring the black mats during the week. There are so many different resources for children to choose to play with, some of the popular ones this week included hanging the washing out on the line, carefully pouring water into our cups, sorting out pegs onto the board and making perfume from petals.

There has been lots of real world play with the children busy at the office tapping away on their computers and answering the phone. They have also enjoyed playing with the shop taking turns to buy things and counting out the required number of coins to pay for their item. We have also been making tracks with the HappyLand resources to run our cars along and building things out of lego. Its been a busy week.
