We have enjoyed exploring the wooden matador construction. These are great for children, as they work out how to fit the poles into the blocks to connect together to build a tower or other interesting objects.

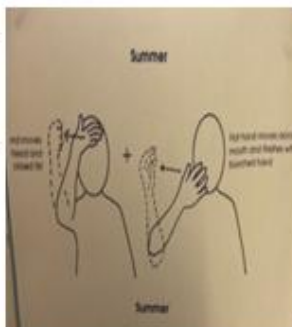
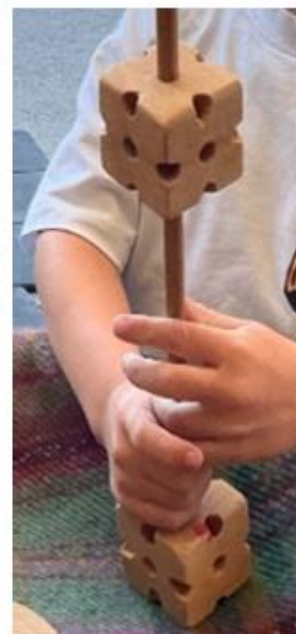
